## **NEW HOMEBUYERS ASSISTANCE PROGRAM FOR REGION**

The East Central Iowa Council of Governments (ECICOG) is pleased to announce their new Homebuyers Assistance Program. The program will help first time homeowners with down-payment assistance, as well as repairs needed to bring the home up to local codes and rehabilitation standards. The Homebuyers Assistance Program will be available to first time homebuyers or veterans in the counties of Benton, Iowa, Johnson, Jones, Linn, and Washington (excluding properties within the city limits of Cedar Rapids and Iowa City).

Not only is this program a great opportunity for ECICOG but also for our region. ECICOG Executive Director Doug Elliott says, "ECICOG offers a variety of housing assistance programs to our region, but this will be the first time we offer a program that was specifically created to assist people in purchasing their first home. This program aligns with ECICOG's commitment to not only expand our own services and capacity based on our core expertise and experience, but also to help further the housing and community development goals within our region."
