- \$590,000 CDBG Downtown Revitalization Grant to improve 6 buildings in Riverside
- \$500,000 CDBG for water main replacement in Wellman
- \$456,000 IFA grant to assist 15 households with housing rehabilitation in Washington
- \$198,944 in federal assistance for Washington County Minibus
- \$167,559 in capital assistance for Washington County Minibus
- \$79,035 in state assistance for Washington County Minibus
