Grant Administration

- \$650,000 CDBG Downtown Revitalization Grant to improve 12 buildings in downtown Anamosa
- \$500,000 HUD grant for downpayment and home rehabilitation repairs
- \$500,000 CDBG water/sewer grant for the Anamosa wastewater treatment plant improvements
- \$160,000 Dillons Military Bridge trail project over Wapsipinicon River in Anamosa
- \$146,103 in federal assistance for Jones County JETS
- \$40,387 from state assistance for Jones County JETS
