- \$2,800,000 Improvements on X14, from Hwy 22 to 520th St SE in Johnson County
- \$1,000,000 EPA Climate Pollution Reduction Grant to complete a regional climate action plan and provide technical assistance to communities in the region for four years
- \$694,112 provide construction management for home rehabilitation repairs to assist 62 households in Johnson County
- \$500,000 Transportation Alternatives Program for the Clear Creek Trail extension project
- \$269,500 for IFA HAF rehabilitation for 7 homeowners in Johnson County
- \$200,470 in federal assistance for Johnson County SEATS
- \$100,000 CDBG-CV grant for Community pantry in North Liberty
- \$38,940 in state assistance for Johnson County SEATS
