- \$243,145 Transportation Alternatives Program for the Wapsipincon Trail.
- \$200,490 federal transportation assistance for Jones County JETS.
- \$53,000 5210 Healthy Choices Count! grant.
- \$7,480 DNR Solid Waste Alternatives grant to begin glass recycling program.
